Guildford City Youth F.C. is running an Under 18's team in the Southern Youth League for the coming season of August 2009 to April 2010.

In our town this is unique, for it's the only Club to provide the youth of Guildford with high standard midweek floodlit football. Football at this standard helps prepare teenagers for entry into adult football at a senior level.

We're looking to build on the foundations laid by the team during their inaugural season last year by combining those players from last year still young enough to play with the new, younger teenagers coming through.

Last season we experienced costs of nearly three thousand pounds to run the team, mainly due to the fees of hiring the floodlit pitch at The Spectrum^{*[1]}, match officials and opposition hospitality. This is a lot for one team which leads me on to the need for sponsorship.
